1. Does your school allow/offer overseas student trips?

Wheaton Warrenville South doesn't offer overseas student trips although performing groups could, conceivably, participate in some international travel. However, if someone should request such a trip, it would be discouraged. Overseas travel such as cultural exchange trips that are organized by teachers, students, or professional travel organizations are independent of the school and district. Any information on such trips must clearly state that they are independent of the school and district. Such groups are not allowed to advertise or solicit in the school(s). Sponsors may hold meetings at the school but must follow all rental procedures. In addition, the sponsor may not use school or district communication services to make arrangements for the trip.
